We intend to prepare students for careers in which an advanced knowledge of culture and languages of Scandinavia are necessary.

The Master program aims to provide theoretical and practical knowledge as a philological discipline (linguistic, literary and cultural studies) of Scandinavia to graduates who will thus be familiar with the fields and methods of academic research and be able to meet the requirements of the PhD program.

The Department for Scandinavian Studies pursue research in a variety of fields and the wide range of topics included in the spectrum of research is reflected in the teaching. Note that the programme does not offer teaching qualifications.
